Me, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one were setting (21) years or more, citizens of the State of Texas, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is WOODLAKE HOME AND PROPERTY SWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE THREE

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR

Specifical Control of the Control of (1) The soul purpose of the corporation is to operate its affairs to the extent it would best meet the needs of the members.

(2) Notwithstanding any of the above statement of purpose, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in the furtherance of the primary purpose of this corporation.

ARTICLE PIVE

As a means of accomplishing the foregoing purpose, the corporation

shall have the following powers:
(1) To perform all of the duties and obligations of the corporation as may be set forth in any declaration of convenants, conditions, and restrictions, and any amendment thereto, applicable to the corporation which shall be filed with the Secretary of the Corporation.

(2) To fix, levy, collect, and enforce payment by any lawful means all charges or assessments pursuant to the Bylaws of the Corporation; to pay all expenses in connection therewith and all other expenses incident to the conduct of the affairs of the Corporation, including licenses, taxes, or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the Corporation.

(3) To acquire by gift, purchase, or otherwise; own, hold, improve, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise, dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the Corporation.

(4) In general, and subject to such limitations and conditions as may be prescribed by law, to exercise such powers which now are or hereafter may be conferred by law mnon a corporation organized for the purpose hereinabove set forth or necessary or incidental to the powers so conferred or conducive to the attainment of the purpose of the corporation.

ARTICLE SIX
